



From the 2005 Vanity Fair "Wine Snob Dictionary":

Hermacinski, Ursula. Adorable and charismatic (by wine-world standards) auctioneer, known as "the Goddess of the Gavel" since Food & Wine magazine nicknamed her thusly. Hermacinski first commanded snob attention at the 1992 Napa Valley Wine Auction, a wine-dork fest whose auctioneers had previously all been men, where she charmed the crowd with her flirty banter and efficient JUICE trafficking. Now co-presiding over the wine-auction department at Zachys, the high-end Westchester County, New York, wine retailer, Hermacinski is especially in demand on the charity circuit, where her presence alone draws crowds of moony, excitable Snob collectors.

Since she stood at the rostrum as the Manhattan Wine Auction's first auctioneer 20 years ago, Ursula has hammered her gavel for the best wine auction houses in the world: Christies and Zachys. In June of 2013, she worked the stage at the Napa Valley Wine Auction to hammer down the largest benefit wine auction total in history: \$16.9 million. She also worked as the Estate Manager at Screaming Eagle and has even written "the book" about wine auctions, "The Wine Lover's Guide to Auctions: The Art & Science of Buying and Selling Wines".

Her experience and vast wine knowledge are truly an asset to present the rare and unique collections we have for auction this evening. With accolades from Robert Mondavi — "truly an exceptional auctioneer" and Decanter Magazine — "Uber-Auctioneer", we are so very fortunate to have her return for our 20th annual Manhattan Wine Auction.







The Syrah grape originated in the Rhone area of France, where the wine it produces is oldworld style, with an expression of its terroir. When cultivated in other parts of the world it takes on a whole new personality, Australia being the prime example, where it is referred to as Shiraz. This wine from "down under" is often described as "peppery" and a "fruit bomb," but big scores come out of there year after year. The tannins extracted from either region lend this wine to exceptional cellaring.

Top producers of Syrah and Shiraz are represented in this lot from across the globe. Torbreck and Chris Ringland are two of Australia's premiere producers. Saxum and Kongsgaard are considered premiere cults of Central California. The northwest is represented by Cayuse, with huge scores every year. Finally we go across the pond to France, including renowned Rhone producers such as Vieux Telegraphe and Pegau.
