MBEF OVERVIEW

Your support of the Manhattan Beach Education Foundation provides our students with programs that inspire learning, enrich teaching, and promote innovation and academic excellence in the public schools of Manhattan Beach.

In 2014-15 our community funded 71 educators who bring our children music, hands-on science, physical education, reading fundamentals, libraries, electives, STEM classes, and Writers Workshop. Our children have twice as many counselors as other districts in California, and learn in small classes that allow teachers to know our children. These kinds of opportunities take more than money; they take dedication and partnership from all community stakeholders.

PUBLIC SCHOOL: WHY PRIVATE DONATIONS?

Unlike other states where counties decide how much to allocate to education, in California, per pupil funding is determined at the state level. In the 1980s, Proposition 13 and legal rulings limited a community's ability to tax its residents to pay for schools. Our property taxes, high as they are, no longer stay in Manhattan Beach. In 2014-15 we received roughly \$7000 per pupil, which puts us at the bottom of the country in funding. With an investment of more than \$5.75M from our community, MBEF is able to increase District spending by 9%.

THE MBEF ENDOWMENT FUND


The concept of an endowment is simple. Monies are placed in a fund and invested to generate income on an ongoing basis, while the original investment (principal) remains untouched. This ensures the availability of funding long into the future. The Endowment protects our schools from the erratic fluctuation of state funding by creating a long-term, stable and secure funding source. Through ongoing contributions and prudent fiscal management, the MBEF Endowment principal has grown to more than \$13M. This year, the Endowment will disburse \$250K to fund MBEF programs.

MANHATTAN BEACH HAS NO PARCEL TAX FOR SCHOOLS

MBUSD is the only top-ranked, unified school district without a parcel tax, utility tax, or both, to supplement state funding. Instead, our generous community and MBEF fill the gap.

Despite the disappointing funding from the state, our outcomes speak for themselves. MBUSD is among the top three K-12 school districts statewide and our students gain access to a rich and diverse curriculum. We host the California Middle School Principal of the Year, two California Teachers of the Year (2014 and 2015), award-winning Model UN and Theater programs, Grammy award-winning Mira Costa Music Program, Gold Ribbon Middle and High Schools, Distinguished Elementary schools... The list goes on.







Mother Nature brings new and unknown challenges to a winemaker each year. In cooler vintages, the grapes need to stay on the vine as long as possible to ensure full maturation and brix. In warmer vintages, the opposite is true and the grapes can be harvested at their peak, thus offering higher yields and more concentrated fruit. Sometimes a freeze or rain is forecast and there is a mad rush to harvest before the fruit is compromised. All of these factors result in wines with a subtly different profile year after year. The consistency of the quality, however, is the onus of the winemaker.

Only the most highly-skilled winemakers can accomplish this, regardless of what is handed to them, and this collection of verticals is a prime example. Doug Shafer with his "Hillside Select," Josh Lowell of Futo, and Andy Erickson of Dalla Valle are legends in the Napa Valley for producing high-scoring wines every year, regardless of the conditions. This lot features a beautifully aged 1993-1998 vertical of Maya, as well as a 2008-2010 vertical. Other beauties include 2006-2009 Futo and a 6-year vertical of Hillside Select.

Vertical collections offer the opportunity to compare different vintages and this collection offers stunning examples from each of these four world-class wineries.
