# MBEF OVERVIEW

Your support of the Manhattan Beach Education Foundation provides our students with programs that inspire learning, enrich teaching, and promote innovation and academic excellence in the Manhattan Beach public schools.

In 2015/16 our community funded 70 educators who bring our children music, hands-on science, physical education, reading fundamentals, libraries, electives, STEM classes, and Writers Workshop. Our children have almost three times as many counselors as other districts in California, and learn in small classes that allow teachers to know our children. These kinds of opportunities take more than money; they take dedication and partnership from all community stakeholders.

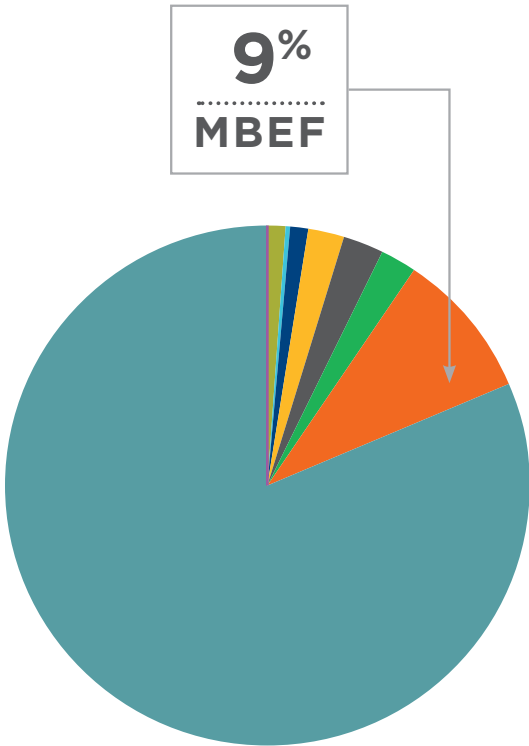
Impressive as these numbers are, they only begin to convey the sheer magnitude of what our students receive as a result of your investment in MBEF. Many of our District’s programs and positions would be eliminated if not for the generous support of our community. Thank you for your partnership.

## PUBLIC SCHOOL: WHY PRIVATE DONATIONS?

Unlike other states where counties decide how much to allocate to education, in California, per pupil funding is determined at the state level. In the 1980s, Proposition 13 and legal rulings limited a community’s ability to tax its residents to pay for schools. Our property taxes, high as they are, no longer stay in Manhattan Beach. In 2014/15 we received roughly \$7,500 per pupil, which puts us at the bottom of the country in funding. With an investment of \$6M from our community, MBEF is able to increase District spending by 9%.

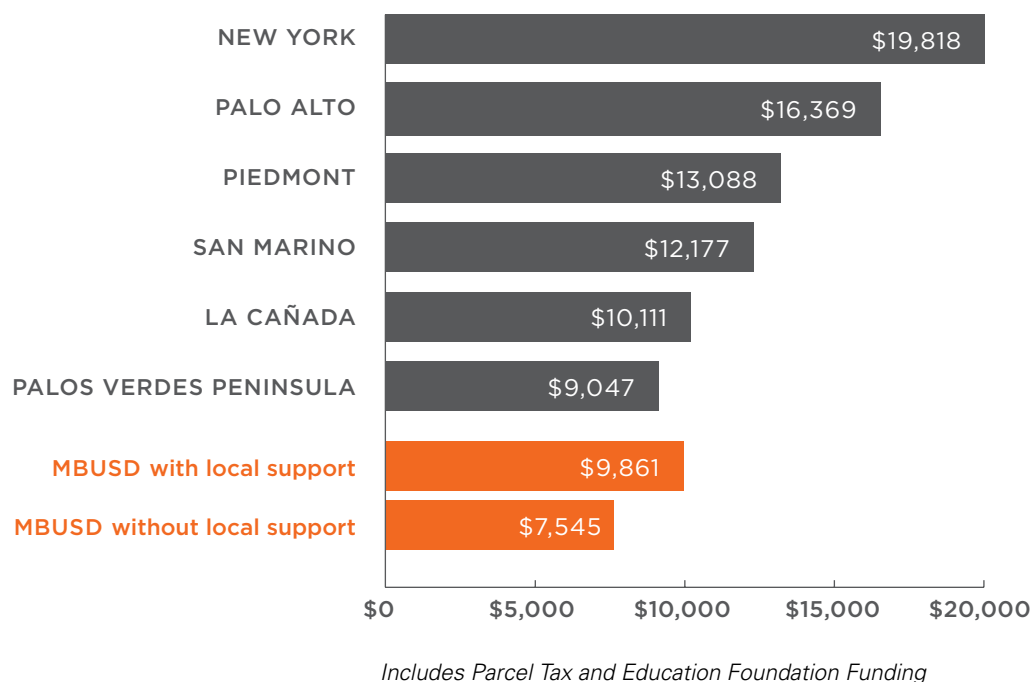
## MANHATTAN BEACH HAS NO PARCEL TAX FOR SCHOOLS

MBUSD is the only top-ranked school district in California without a parcel tax, utility tax, or both, to supplement state funding. Instead, our generous community and MBEF fill the gap.

All of the school districts listed above also have Education Foundations that provide anywhere from \$1M - \$6M of funding each year, in addition to their parcel tax revenue.

## PER PUPIL FUNDING - 2014/15



Despite the disappointing funding from the state, MBUSD outcomes speak for themselves. MBUSD is among the top K-12 school districts statewide and our students gain access to a rich and diverse curriculum. We host California Teachers of the Year (2014 and 2015), award-winning Model UN and Theater programs, Grammy award-winning Mira Costa Music Program, Gold Ribbon Middle and High Schools, Distinguished, Gold, and Blue Ribbon Elementary schools...The list goes on.

## THE MBEF ENDOWMENT FUND

The concept of an endowment is simple. Monies are placed in a fund and invested to generate income on an ongoing basis, while the original investment (principal) remains untouched. This ensures the availability of funding long into the future. The MBEF Endowment protects our schools from the erratic fluctuations of state funding by creating a long-term, stable and secure funding source. Through ongoing contributions and prudent fiscal management, the MBEF Endowment has grown to \$13M. This year the Endowment disbursed \$300,000 to fund MBEF programs.

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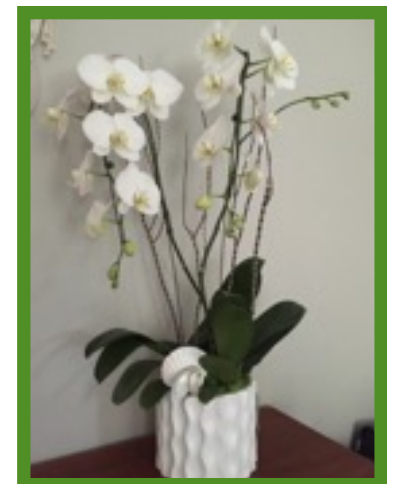
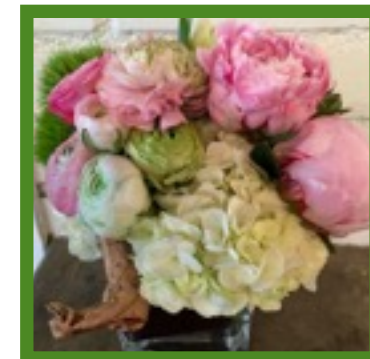
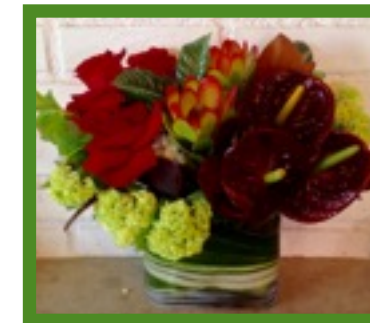
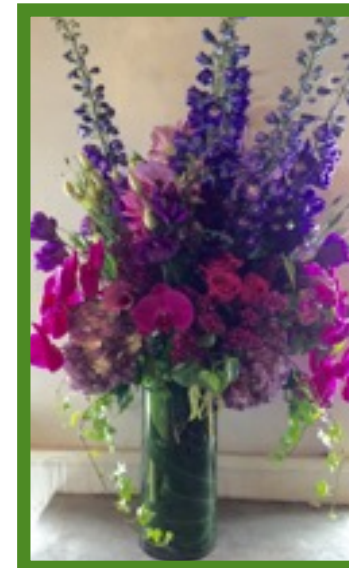


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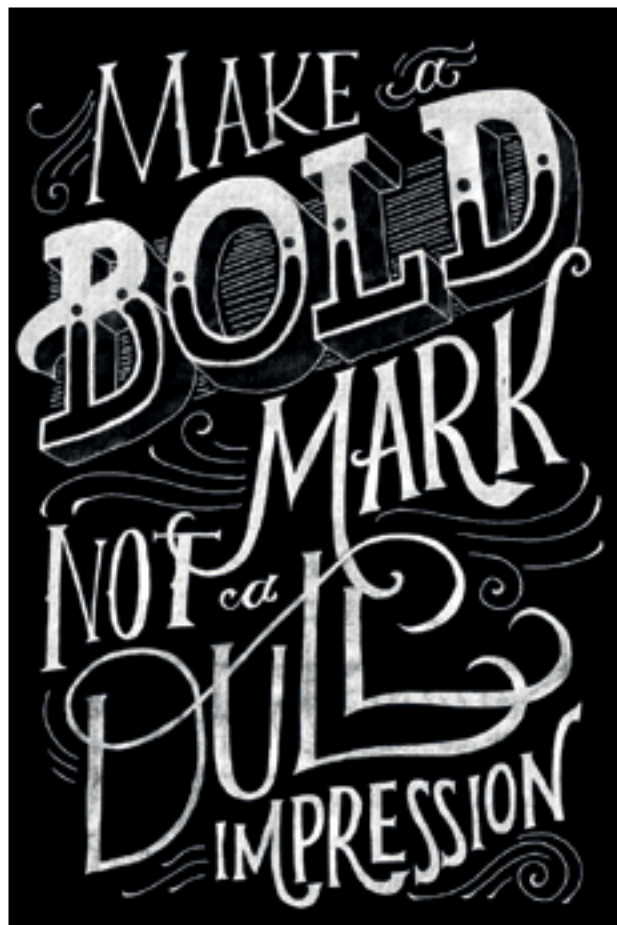


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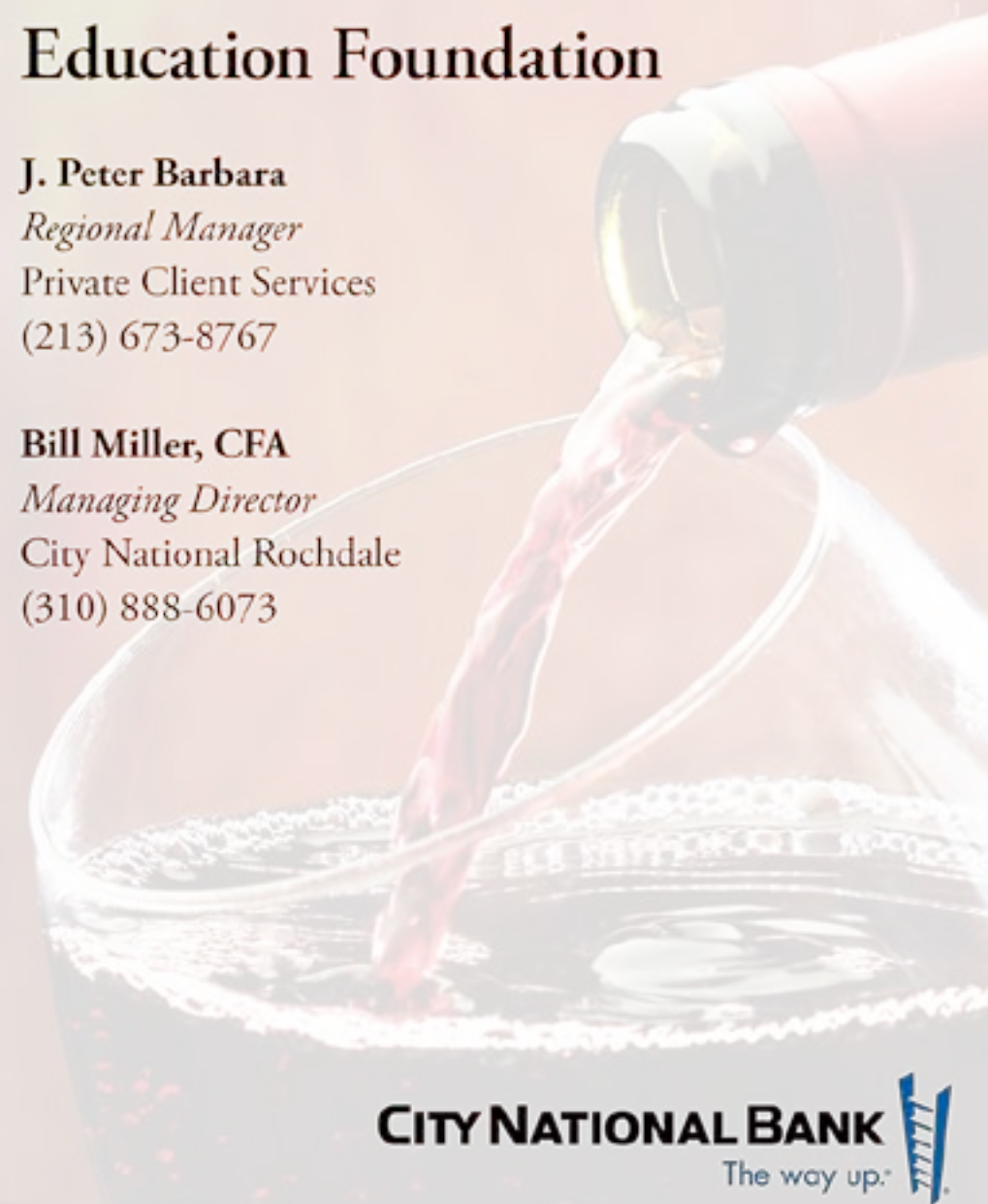
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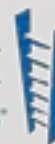
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## MEET GREG QUIROGA AUCTIONEER
