Since the Manhattan Wine Auction became a significant element of the Manhattan Beach Education Foundation's efforts to support our local schools, the artwork associated with the event has been highly anticipated each year.

Over the past 29 years, the Manhattan Wine Auction invitation has captured both the excitement of the event and the appreciation of quality wine in an imaginative way. From our sandy beaches depicted as a vineyard, to the pier serving as a chilling bucket, the Manhattan Wine Auction invitation art itself has become iconic.

This year, artist Jillian Roper of Jump Jack Studio was commissioned to create a linograph of our beautiful Manhattan Beach pier and beachfront. The hand-cut woodblock was then used to create a letterpress plate that became the label on an exclusive bottle of Sextant wine and elegant invitation that are reminiscent of a sophisticated Napa winery.

2023 LEGACY AWARD

G. BRADFORD JONES & JOAN HOOD JONES

The Manhattan Beach Education Foundation Legacy Award celebrates individuals who demonstrate an unwavering commitment to leadership, philanthropy, and the MBEF mission. First introduced in 2020, the Legacy Award honors those who have had an immeasurable impact on our public schools and our community.



This year, the MBEF Board of Directors is pleased to honor G. Bradford Jones and Joan Hood Jones as the recipients of the 2023 MBEF Legacy Award.

For over 30 years, Brad and Joan have supported MBEF in nearly every way possible. MBEF would not be where we are today without their commitment and dedication.

Brad and Joan are proud parents of three children who attended Manhattan Beach schools, and recognized early on that a strong public-school system requires partnership with parents and the greater community. They were among a small group of early trailblazers who were committed to supporting our schools and led the way for countless others to follow in their footsteps.

Brad served on the MBEF Board for nearly a decade, and for five years as President. He also served on the Business Advisory Council, President’s Advisory Council, and the Superintendent’s Circle. During Brad’s tenure, the MBEF Endowment was started with a \$10,000 investment and a vision for the future. The Endowment has now reached \$23 million and has dispersed over \$6 million to our schools. It remains a gift to our community that will support generations of students to come.

Joan was equally engaged running our fine city during those years. She served on the Manhattan Beach City Council from 1994-2000, and as Mayor in 1997-1998. She also served on the MBEF Board, the MBEF Endowment Board, and the Mira Costa High School PTA. Joan has brought her expertise to numerous other boards



throughout the greater Los Angeles area and has been instrumental in the modernization of the Manhattan Beach Community Center, which will provide a beautiful gathering place and backdrop for civic events well into the future once completed.

In addition to their volunteerism and leadership, Brad and Joan have shared their good fortune with our community as philanthropists. They have been among MBEF’s most generous donors and have provided sustained funding to MBEF and the MBEF Endowment for over 30 years.

Joan and Brad have also been closely involved with the Wine Auction since its inception and have been a huge part of the event’s growth and success. They open their cellar, donate (very) fine wines, host events, and lend their time and talents to ensure the Wine Auction remains the South Bay’s *biggest party with a purpose*. Although their kids have graduated high school, Joan and Brad continue to attend the Wine Auction, helping us to friend-raise and reconnect with one another year after year. Their continued involvement and support reminds us how fortunate we are to be part of a community of people who work tirelessly to ensure our children can thrive.

It is with great appreciation and gratitude that we honor Brad and Joan, individually and jointly, for their leadership, generosity and commitment to strengthening our public schools and our community. On behalf of our students, our schools, and all of Manhattan Beach, thank you!

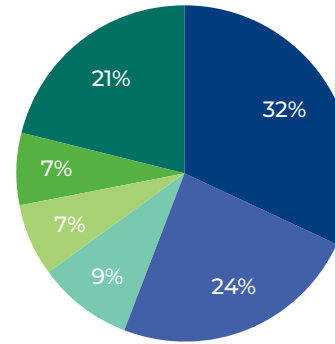
MBEF was founded to ensure that all Manhattan Beach students have access to a superior public-school education. Since its start four decades ago, MBEF has provided supplemental funding to ensure that our schools are filled with programs and opportunities that would not otherwise be possible. Today, MBEF continues to play a significant role in supporting — in small or large part — nearly every academic pursuit and enrichment opportunity across all of our campuses.

Without the support of our community through MBEF, our public schools in Manhattan Beach would look drastically different. The fact is our state provides barely enough to fund the basics — not the enriched educational opportunities that we strive to provide our children. Funding from MBEF supports a breadth of educational experiences across many disciplines, including music and the arts, physical education, academic and college counseling, reading and writing, libraries, and STEM.

The generous support of MBEF year after year is a testament to the collective commitment to ensure our schools are filled with possibilities for our students.

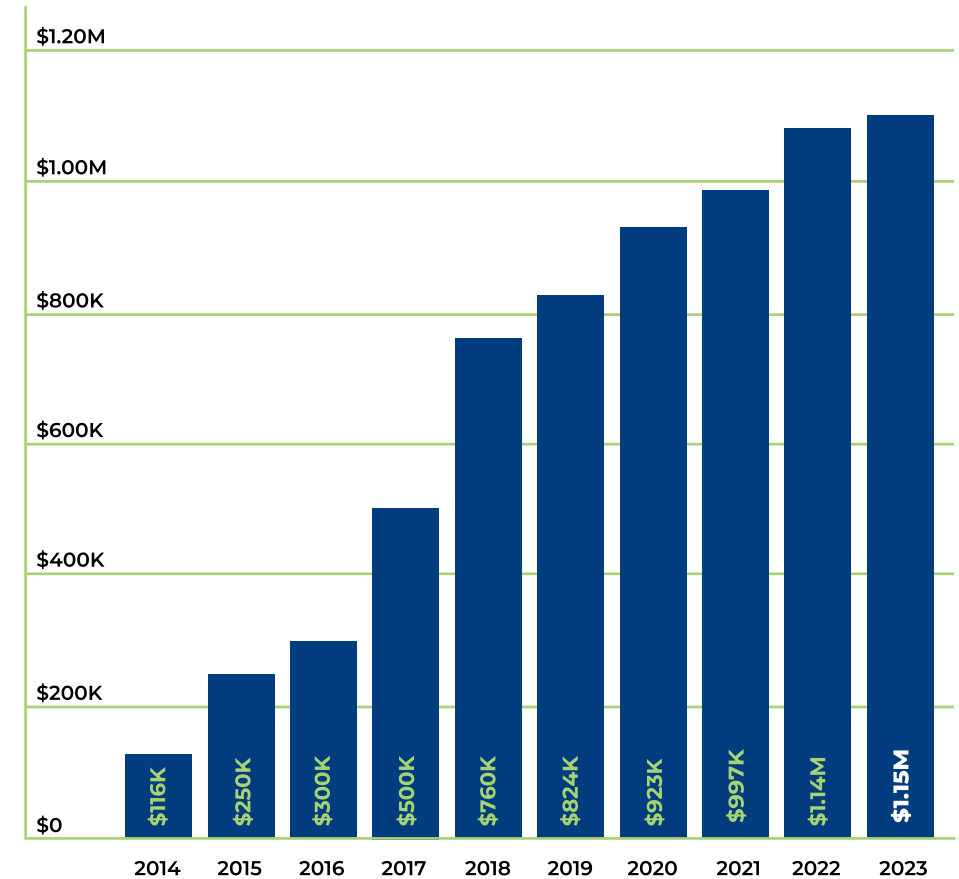
The MBEF Endowment provides MBEF with a continuing and sustainable funding source that will expand and enhance the quality of public education in Manhattan Beach, now and for generations to come.

In 1986, a group of forward-thinking parents and community members had the foresight to establish the MBEF Endowment with an initial investment of \$10,000. For over 35 years, generous gifts from supporters and prudent investing have fueled the balance. Your support of the Manhattan Wine Auction ensures its continued growth.

The MBEF Endowment helps serve our public schools with a sustainable source of funding by providing an annual disbursement that supports immediate program needs while still preserving the principle of the investment. The Endowment's annual return on investment continues to grow as the principle grows, helping to make up for the instability of public-school funding at the state level.

With the Endowment Fund currently at \$23 million, the annual contribution to MBEF's programs in the 2023-24 school year will exceed \$1.1 million once again, accounting for 19% of MBEF's overall grant to the district. As a myriad of challenges continue to face public education in our state, the MBEF Endowment provides a sustainable and reliable source of revenue that is critical to the quality of our public schools.

This year, the Manhattan Beach Education Foundation (MBEF) celebrates our 40th anniversary of supporting Manhattan Beach public schools. Founded on the vision of providing all students with an exceptional education, MBEF has been instrumental in the success of our public schools.

Over the past four decades, MBEF has directed significant funding to build a foundation of excellence in our schools. What started with a few thousand dollars to support the arts in 1983, has grown into a multi-million-dollar commitment that maintains rigorous academics and a breadth of hands-on enrichment experiences for all students in the Manhattan Beach Unified School District.

In 2023, our community came together to celebrate three important milestones in our organization’s history – 40 years since our founding, \$100 million dollars to support our schools, and the unveiling of the Seeds of Knowledge Community Recognition Project.

Past and present MBEF Presidents and board members, City Councilmembers, MBUSD Trustees, administrators and educators, parents, donors and residents joined in the celebration.

The Seeds of Knowledge art installation in Metlox Plaza acknowledges the incredible community of educators, parents, students, volunteers, and donors who value and support education in Manhattan Beach. It not only celebrates the decades of support of our schools through MBEF and the Endowment, but also invites viewers to explore the significance of education in our lives through the eyes of a child discovering the world — the layers of earth beneath her, the environment around her, and the future represented in the stars.
