JOHN OSHIRO

The Manhattan Beach Education Foundation Legacy Award celebrates individuals who demonstrate an unwavering commitment to leadership, philanthropy, and the MBEF mission. This year, we are pleased to honor John Oshiro as the recipient of the 2024 MBEF Legacy Award.

It's hard to find someone who has contributed more to MBEF and our schools than John Oshiro has over the past 25 years. While John's contributions to MBEF and the Manhattan Wine Auction have been tremendously generous, so has the gift of his time and spirit. We are not just recognizing his donations tonight, we are celebrating the generous gifts of his time, his talents and his heart to our schools and our community.



When his daughter was in elementary school, John recognized that a strong public school system requires everyone in the community to pitch in to get things done. John embraced that mentality, and has been leading by example, encouraging community participation and support for our schools for three decades.

In addition to having a successful career as a software engineer, John never missed a chance to be involved. He served on the Pennekamp PTA Board and on the Council of PTAs before joining the MBEF Board in 2000. During John's tenure on the board, he also volunteered to handle the MBEF operational technology needs, a volunteer role he is still actively engaged in today.

His involvement with the Manhattan Wine Auction also began in 2000 when he joined the Wine Advisory Board. John co-chaired the Auction for three years, and he continues to help with his generous wine donations and his work on the post-auction organization. MBEF estimates that he and Jeanne have donated over 850 bottles of wine to the Manhattan Wine Auction over the past 25 years. John's participation in the Wine Auction has been a huge part of the event's growth and success.

John has always been an advocate for the MBUSD instrumental music programs. He volunteered to assist with the start of the elementary orchestra program and also assisted with the MBMS music

program. He volunteered with the Mira Costa Orchestra from its start in 2002 and formed the Orchestra Booster Club to facilitate a performance at Carnegie Hall in 2006.

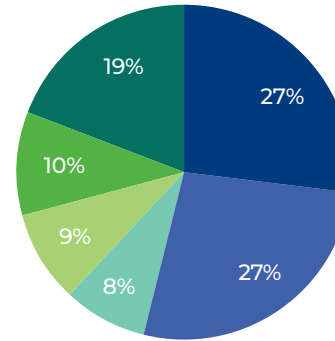
The Manhattan Beach Education Foundation (MBEF) is a community driven fundraising organization, which supplements state funding for programs that inspire learning, enrich teaching, and promote innovation and academic excellence in the public schools of Manhattan Beach.

MBEF was founded to ensure that all Manhattan Beach students have access to a superior public-school education. Since its start four decades ago, MBEF has provided supplemental funding to ensure that our schools are filled with programs and opportunities that would not otherwise be possible. Today, MBEF continues to play a significant role in supporting — in small or large part — nearly every academic pursuit and enrichment opportunity across all of our campuses.

Without the support of our community through MBEF, our public schools in Manhattan Beach would look drastically different. The fact is our state provides barely enough to fund the basics — not the enriched educational opportunities that we strive to provide our children. Funding from MBEF supports a breadth of educational experiences across many disciplines, including music and the arts, physical education, academic and college counseling, reading and writing, libraries, and STEAM.

The generous support of MBEF year after year is a testament to the collective commitment to ensure our schools are filled with possibilities for our students.

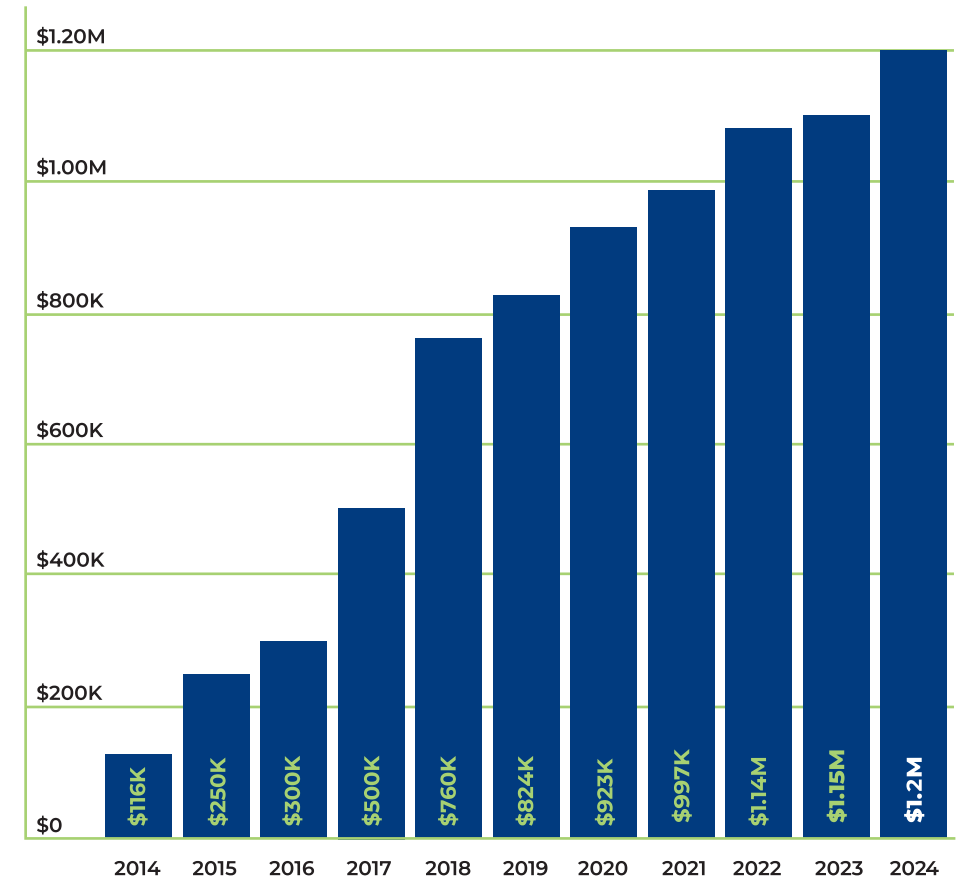
The MBEF Endowment provides MBEF with a continuing and sustainable funding source that will expand and enhance the quality of public education in Manhattan Beach, now and for generations to come.

In 1986, a group of forward-thinking parents and community members had the foresight to establish the MBEF Endowment with an initial investment of \$10,000. For over 35 years, generous gifts from supporters and prudent investing have fueled the balance. Community support of the Manhattan Wine Auction ensures its continued growth.

The MBEF Endowment helps serve our public schools with a sustainable source of funding by providing an annual disbursement that supports immediate program needs while still preserving the principle of the investment. The Endowment's annual return on investment continues to grow as the principle grows, helping to make up for the instability of public-school funding at the state level.

With the Endowment Fund currently at \$25 million, the annual contribution to MBEF's programs in the 2024-25 school year will hit \$1.2 million, accounting for 19% of MBEF's overall grant to the district. As a myriad of challenges continue to face public education in our state, the MBEF Endowment provides a sustainable and reliable source of revenue that is critical to the quality of our public schools.

COMMUNITY

WINE DONORS

The Manhattan Wine Auction has developed into one of the most famous food and wine events in Southern California — and it's still dedicated solely to the public schools of Manhattan Beach. As the Auction has grown in reputation, so has the support from our community.

Over 80% of the wines that are auctioned off as part of the silent and live auctions are donated by members of our community, and the rest come from the wineries who participate in the Wine Auction.

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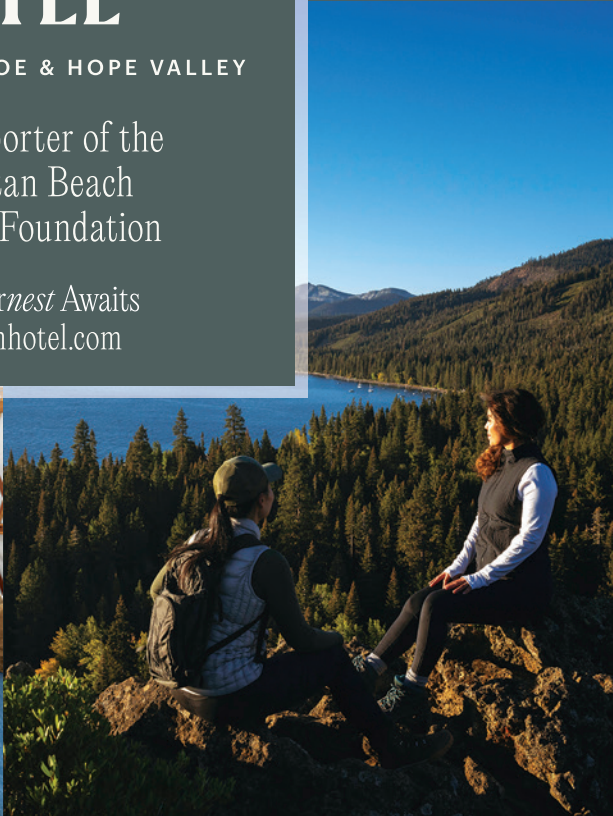

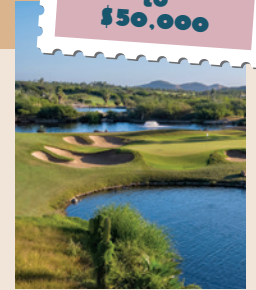

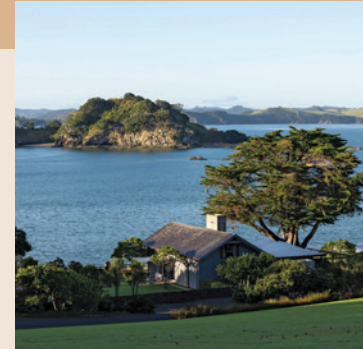

First up, the 2003 Domus is plum in color, with an aromatic nose of violets, raspberries and worn leather. Flavors begin discreetly with essences of cumin and drank red fruit and build up to a suppleness and elegance that is enveloping. The finish is long, fragrant and fresh, with an intensity of tobacco and truffle notes. The wine is charismatic, with a Bordeaux-like style.

The 2005 Dunn Vineyards is very concentrated, with a formidable core of black currant and blackberry fruit. Bone dry, but with that subtle impression of sweetness that comes from ripe Cabernet. Dried mushroom tones contribute an appetizing, savory component and a trace of black licorice. The tannins are fine-grained and supple, with an impression of chewiness fleshing out the aftertaste.

The 2017 Christophe Baron unwinds in the glass with scents of crisp orchard fruit, tangerine oil, honeycomb, yellow plums and freshly baked bread. Full-bodied, vinous and textural, it's rich and incisive, with a tightly coiled core of concentrated fruit and a long, saline and delicately exotic finish.

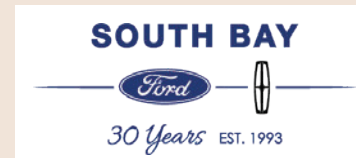

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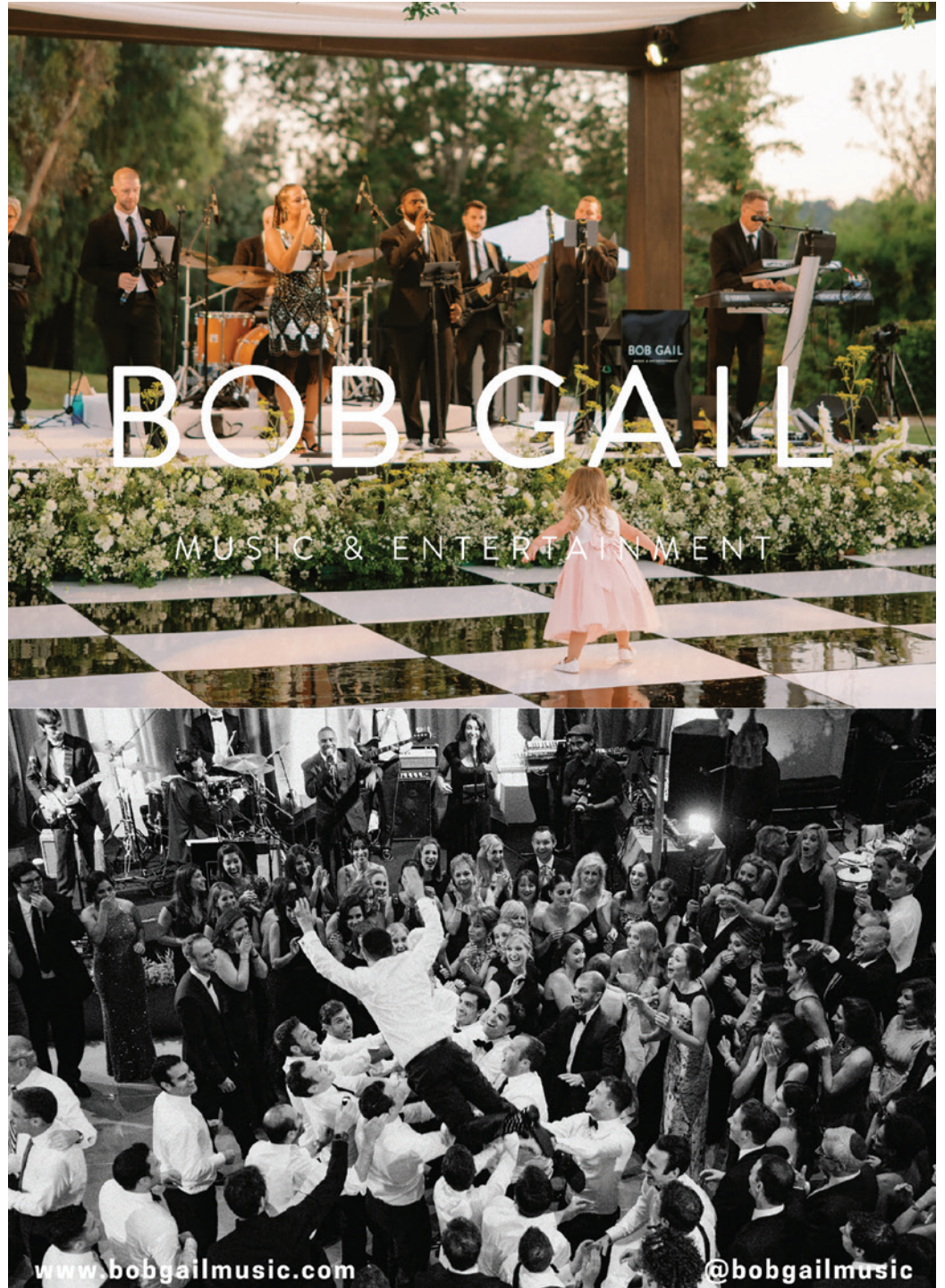
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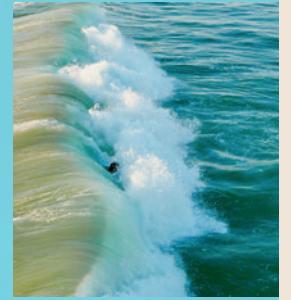
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
